



Important Rule Changes for the 2007-2008 AASBD Racing Season

The current rule book is in the process of being finalized for publication. The major changes for the 2007-2008 Racing Season are outlined below.

Local and Rally Regions

Both the Local and Rally programs will be using a *Region* format. We have modified the previous Local Regions and Rally Districts and created new Regions as follows:

Important Rule Changes for the 2007-2008 AASBD Racing Season

Age Requirements and Progression/Regression of Divisions

Participants in the Stock Division must be eight (8) years of age by the date of the first Local and/or Rally race in which they participate. They must not turn fourteen (14) years of age on or before August 1. Proof of age is required.

If a participant becomes a Local and/or Rally Stock Division Champion he or she is permitted to progress to the Super Stock Division.

Participants in the Super Stock Division must be ten (10) years of age by the date of the first Local and/or Rally race in which they participate. They must not turn eighteen (18) years of age on or before August 1. Proof of age is required.

Participants in the Masters Division must be ten (10) years of age by the date of the Local and/or Rally race in which they participate. They must not turn eighteen (18) years of age on or before August 1. Proof of age is required.

Regression between divisions is permitted as long as the participant is age appropriate.
